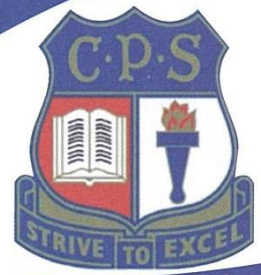

Block J and Block JA the former Distance Education buildings are now part of the Casino Public Schools building assets. The buildings provide three permanent classrooms. This means that all four of the demountable classrooms will be released from service at the end of this year and will be removed from the site so time in the future.

The classrooms are currently being painted. New carpet and wall display boards will be installed in the coming week. (see yellow arrow)
