This is enabling us to set our school up ready for next year's Kindergarten children to ensure they have every opportunity to start school in a happy and confident way. We are now acknowledging the enrolment of children in Kindergarten 2020. Letters have been mailed to families to confirm enrolment and more will follow this week.

Thank you to the families who do not live in the school's enrolment area who have submitted an out of area application for enrolment for their child. These applications are now being considered and families will be contacted within the next two weeks to inform them of where the process for seeking enrolment is up to.

If you haven't made an application to enrol your child in 2020 it is very important that you do so within the next week. Applications for enrolment in Kindergarten at Casino PS in 2020 close on Friday, September 6.

Our school has organised visits with Preschools in Weeks 9 and 10 this term so our Kinder 2020 teachers have opportunities to get know the children in their current learning settings. Kindergarten 2020 orientation days will be held on Mondays, October 21 & 28 and November 4 & 11 from 9.30 am to 1.00 pm. Only children who have an application for enrolment submitted are invited to the orientation days.

This Friday Heidi-Rose Adams (4/5H), Tilly Spittles (4K), Michael Melrose (6R) and Alice McBride (5CG) will be representing Casino Public School at the Regional Premier's Spelling Bee Finals being held at Ballina Public School. Heidi-Rose and Tilly will be competing in the Junior Competition and Michael and Alice representing Casino Public School in the Senior Competition. The winners and runners up from both sections at the Regional Spelling Bee will have the opportunity to attend the State Finals being held in Sydney later in the year. Students from our school have recently undertaken an educational tour of the national capital. Students had the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$30 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.
