#### SCHOLASTIC BOOK CLUB

Pamphlets have been sent home today for Issue 1 Book Club. If you would like to make a purchase, please clearly fill in order forms and return to school along with payment no later than 9am Wednesday 19 February.

Casino Public School has for some time, been involved with Scholastic Book Clubs. Eight times a year, your child(ren) will have the opportunity to purchase books and educational products aimed at their reading level and most importantly their interest.

Our school receives bonus points for these purchases which can then be redeemed for books and equipment to be used in classrooms.

There is **no obligation to buy** from any of the brochures, but we do hope you take a little time to browse through them with your child(ren) and consider Book Club as a way of encouraging reading and learning outside normal classroom activities.

Each issue will be distributed to children and dates for ordering will be advised through classroom teachers and through the CPS Newsletter. If you do allow your child(ren) to order it would be appreciated if their name and class are clearly marked on the order form and returned (with correct payment) in advance of the closing date to the Administration Office.

You can also order online. It is easy to order. The Book Club LOOP platform for parents allows you to pay by credit card. Your child's order is submitted directly to school and the books will be delivered to class. You can place your child's order at scholastic.com.au/loop or by using the LOOP app, which can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play.

Orders usually take 1-2 weeks to arrive. In the event that items ordered are unavailable, credit vouchers can be supplied for future use, or, alternatively, refunds can be arranged through Scholastic.

#### **CARE PACKAGES FOR TROOPS**

3S and 3T have taken on board the "Care Packages for Troops" project. We aim to send as many care packages as we can to our overseas troops, by the end of March, ready to be received around ANZAC Day. At this current point in time, there are over 2500 troops deployed on 9 separate operations overseas.
