Curriculum Bites

Writing is an extremely hard skill to learn, let alone master! There are a lot of components that need to be explicitly taught before children can compose a story or piece of writing independently. Children need to know how to hear the sounds and how to write the graphemes or letters. They need to know how break apart a word and stick or blend the sounds together to write a word. Then how words go together to make a sentence and how multiple sentences can make a paragraph. Once they have these skills then the craft of writing can all come together!


