#### Yarn And Play

Djanangmum Preschool is an important part of Casino Public School and provides a P-6 pathway for students at Casino Public School. Out expert staff in the preschool provide rich learning experiences for students in the year prior to commencing school and we are appreciative of the opportunities they provide.

#### **Before and After School Care**

Casino Public School now has before and after school care which is run by Rainbow Region kids. This service offers care from 7am until 8.40am and 3.10 until 6pm on school days and is registered for the childcare rebate. A reminder to all families that school supervision does not begin until 8.40am. Students should not be left at school prior to this time as there is no supervision. If your child needs to be dropped to school prior to 8.40 families are asked to access the BASC service. Further information about the service is included in this newsletter or can be obtained at the school office. Please support our school to keep your children safe by not dropping them to school prior to 8.40.

#### **Sentral Parent Portal**

All families are strongly encouraged to use the Sentral Parent Portal for non-urgent communication with teachers. Requests that are not time sensitive can be made through the portal. Teachers will check their messages at least once a day. Families should be aware that teachers will not engage in conversations about student behaviour or more complex matters over the portal - these will require a phone conversation or face to face discussion.

All URGENT or TIME SENSITIVE matters requiring attention, including changes to buses or pick up and drop off routines should be made via phone to the school office. Details of how to download the app and access the portal are included in this newsletter. If you require support please contact the school office and we will arrange a time when a staff member explain the process.

#### **Attendance**

A reminder that the last day for term 2 for staff and students is Friday 12th April. Students are required to attend school every day it is open, and they are able. Casino Public School is currently sitting above state average for student attendance, and we would love to keep it this way! Attending school regularly not only support student learning it also helps them build connections and positive relationships. 
